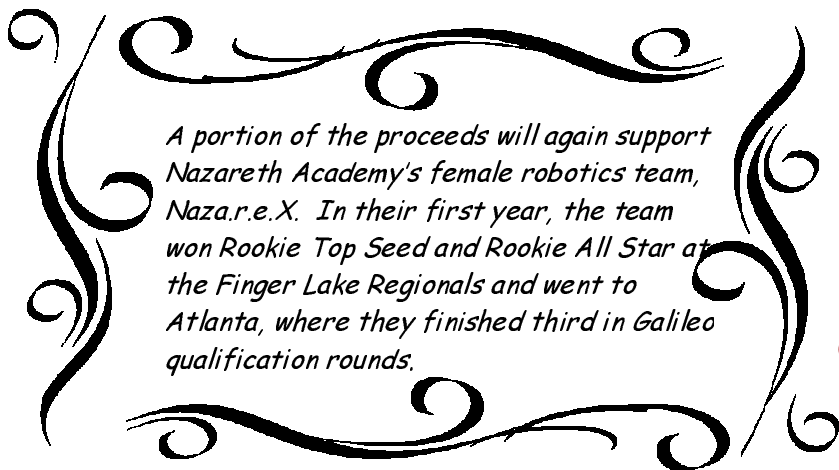

TRAINING CREDITS

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation has approved five training contact hours toward Wastewater Operator Re-certification.
